

2019 Walk at Work Catered Lunch Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter the competition forms part of the competition conditions.
2. Competition entry is deemed acceptance of these competition conditions.
3. Prizes: There is one major prize for this competition. Major prize: 1x \$250 voucher for a work team catered lunch thanks to Qld Walks. The winning team will nominate their caterer or restaurant of choice and Qld Walks will make payment to that organisation/team on an agreed date. The prize is not exchangeable or transferable, unless deemed so by the prize provider, and cannot be redeemed for cash. If the full amount of the voucher is not redeemed, the unused balance will be forfeited. Any additional expenses incurred by the prize winners, other than those outlined in these competition conditions, are the responsibility of the prize winners. Prizes are themselves subject to the specific terms and conditions of the prize providers. The prizes must be redeemed by the prizewinner unless the prizewinner is under 18 years of age, in which case the prize winner's parent or guardian is required to redeem the prize on the prize winner's behalf.
4. The competition period: The competition opens at 6.00 am on Monday 19 August 2019 and closes at 11:59pm on Friday 23 August 2019.
5. How to enter: Teams that register for 2019 Walk at Work Week and post photos of their team participating each business day from 19 - 23 August 2019 via the Qld Walks Facebook page (using #walkatworkweek) will automatically be entered in the random draw.
6. Eligibility: To be eligible to enter this competition, a person must: a) the nominated contact for a work team registering for 2019 Walk at Work Week; b) post at least one photo of their team participating in a 2019 Walk at Work Week related activity to Facebook each day from Monday 19 to Friday 23 August; c) use the hashtag #walkatworkweek on each Facebook post d) be over the age of 18 or have the consent of a parent or guardian to enter the competition.
7. Competition Draw: Winners will be randomly drawn by a Qld Walks executive member. The winner of the major prize will be the first eligible entry randomly drawn.
8. Winner Notification: The winner will be notified by email/telephone, on or before Friday 30 August 2019 by Qld Walks. If the winner is not contactable, Qld Walks continue to attempt to contact them until Friday 7 September 2019.
9. Re-Draw: If the winner does not claim the prize or cannot be contacted by phone or email by Friday 7 September, the Promoter will redraw the prize winner until a contactable winner has been located and the prize is claimed.
10. No Liability of Promoter: The Promoter accepts no responsibility whatsoever for late, misplaced, lost or ineligible entries. The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability or merchantability of the prizes. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or for any personal injury sustained in connection with the entry into the competition or acceptance of the prize. This paragraph is not intended to exclude any liability which cannot be excluded under Australian consumer protection laws. Any such liability is limited to the resupply of the prize.

Force Majeure: If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned (including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter), which corrupts or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify all entries from any individual who tampers with, or benefits from tampering with, the entry process which as a result corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the competition.

In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions.
